Introduction of new portals

From 1 July 2016, LPI will discontinue its Spatial Information eXchange (SIX) portal, replacing it with three new portals that reflect its new business arrangements. You will find the background to these business arrangements in LPI Circular 2016-07 and on the LPI website.

New portals

The three new portals are:

- LPI Online Titling and Registry Services <u>https://online.lpi.nsw.gov.au</u>
- Property NSW Valuation Portal Valuation Services www.valuation.property.nsw.gov.au
- Spatial Services Portal Spatial Services will retain the current U www.six.nsw.gov.au

The portals will not be available until 1 July 2016.

Which portal to use

In the <u>Summary of Services</u> you will find information about which portal to use for the products and services you need.

Products and services are not duplicated across the portals so you might need to use more than one portal to complete a business transaction.

Services available from each portal

The products and services that are currently provided through the SIX portal will still be available but will be delivered across the three new portals.

You will find a list of the services and applications in the Summary of Services. You may see services listed that you will not be able to access as your user profile determines which services are available to you.

From 1 July 2016, LPI will no longer provide online land title searches and products that attract a fee. To access these fee-based searches and products please contact one of LPI's <u>authorised</u> <u>Information Brokers</u> (brokers) who will be the only suppliers.

Free searches will continue to be available at LPI Online (Titling and Registry Services) or Property NSW Valuation Portal (Valuation Services) and no login credentials will be required.

Differences in look and feel

The new portals have been designed for specific business needs and you will notice some changes to their look and feel. In the <u>Summary of Services</u> you can see images of the new look and feel for each portal.

Login

You will need a new login for each portal you use. We will send this information to all portal users before 1 July 2016.
