Access to land title searches and related products: changes from 1 July 2016

Customers who wish to purchase land title searches and related products online will need to use Land and Property Information's (LPI) network of approved information brokers from 1 July 2016. Over 90% of LPI's customers already use our broker network and there is no longer any reason for LPI to duplicate the services they provide.
